SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The scope of work shall include but not limited to daily sweeping of the area in and around buildings, clearing of drains (including internal drains) and putting them in dust bins and then disposing the same at proper disposal sites. However the scope of work can be increase by EIC.
2. The contractors shall maintain a complaint book, which will be available in the office of the Jr. Engineer/ AE/ Engineer concerned so that residents of the colony/ office staff could write their complaints including cleaning of toilets and washbasins. After attending the complaints the contractor will take the signature of the employee and submit the same in the officer In Charge.
3. Besides sweeping the contractor has to clean the gum boot, helmet twice or thrice time in a day of RHEP Site offices at various locations.
4. **PERFORMANCE:**
 - (a) The contractor or his/ her authorized representative shall himself/herself available in the colony area/office area so that he/she can be contacted any odd hours. He/She should also report to Jr. Engineer/Asstt. Engineer/ Engineer (I/C) daily to receive instructions about the job.
 - (b) The brooms, cleaning equipments and any other day to day materials required for general sanitation and sweeping shall be arranged by the contractor at his own cost.
 - (c) No person below the age of 18 year shall be employed.
 - (d) In case of non- deployment of adequate manpower by the contractor at any place resulting in unsatisfactory performance deduction shall be made minimum equivalent to the wages of person not deployed, which can be extended maximum up to double the wages as per the opinion of the EIC depending upon the area/ site conditions.
 - (e) In case the performance of the contractor is not found satisfactory and there are complaints against him/ her, his/ her contract can be terminated by giving fifteen (15) days notice.
5. **PERIOD CONTRACT:**

The contract shall be valid for one (01) year from the actual date of commencement of work. Further extension, if required, shall be on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon.

6. The contractor shall abide all acts/ laws and other statutory provisions rules, regulation byelaws as are applicable or which might become applicable with regard to the performance of work / engagement of the workers etc.
 - (a) The contractor will have to make his/ her own arrangement for residential accommodation for himself/ herself and his/ her workers and no facilities or allowance shall be reimbursed by SJVNL.
 - (b) The payment in respect of EPF and ESI contribution, as applicable shall be made by the contractor and no liability on this account shall be born by SJVNL.
 - (c) The contractor shall have to satisfy and give proof to EIC of having made payment to labour for the period for which the bill has been submitted.
 - (d) The bid of contractor whose quoted rates are found to be unworkable to comply with all the provision of the Minimum Wages Act-1948 and rules framed there under, is liable to be rejected and no claim whatever in this regard shall be entertained by SJVNL.
 - e) The workman to be engaged shall be exclusively on account and they shall have no right in any way for direct or indirect employment in SJVNL. During the currency of contact and after its expiry or termination no employee of the contractor who have ever worked on contact against this work will be offered direct or indirect employment of SJVNL.
7. Rates quoted by the contractor shall include all over heads components such as weekly off, holidays houses rent, administrative charges etc. and if accepted by the management of SJVN Limited they shall remain firm during the currency of contract.
8. In case of any dispute or difference arising out of the contractor or in connection with the contract, the same shall be referred to the Sole Arbitrator, who shall be appointed by the Head of Project, RHEP, SJVN Limited, Jhakri. The award of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties.
9. Working hour shall be decided by EIC so that the work of sweeping can be completed before 9.30 am.

Note:

All the above special conditions shall supersede the Tender Document clauses of Volume-I and shall become the part of contract agreement.
